

Mouthpiece Buzzing

Basis of Sound

- -All Brass Instruments require lip vibrations or buzzing
- -The buzz is the most important part of the sound
- -All playing should be doable on the mouthpiece, then applied on the Instrument

Core and Resonance of Buzz

- -Strive for a buzz-ier or ZZZZZ kind of sound
- -Avoid the airiness to the sound: this means the embouchure is too spread
- -Think about focusing the lips forward
- -Louder is okay
- -Keep the corners of the embouchure firm and set

Sirens

- -Buzz 1 octave up and down
- -Strive for the buzzy, focused, and resonant sound on the mouthpiece
- -Try the sirens in other registers or octaves

Mouthpiece Practicing

- -Start each practice session on the mouthpiece only
- -Strive for the core and focus to use for the rest of the session
